Makeup, Hair and Costumes

- Arrive to makeup call with faces freshly washed, free of any makeup except moisturizer and primer. You can moisturize and prime once at call as well. If washing your face is not plausible, please wipe down face, neck (front and back) and ears with baby wipes or make up removing clothes.
- Before applying makeup, foundation top (i.e. camisole or undershirt) should be on underneath a button or zip down top.
- GIRLS: Please remove all makeup worn during the day before coming to make up call. No makeup during the day is ideal. When removing make up make sure to pay special attention to eyes, lips, and eyebrows.
- BOYS: Please shave as close to makeup call as possible. If you have facial hair for the show that doesn't cover your entire face, please make sure the rest is shaved. (If you only have a mustache for the show, make sure the rest of your face is shaved.)
- PLEASE MAINTAIN SKINTONE DURING SHOW. This means sunscreen while outside, no selftanners or bronzers and no tanning.
- Please bring items on your hair and makeup list to all dress rehearsals and shows. Put items in a container or one-gallon zip lock bag, clearly marked with your name. Please initial individual items to make sure no one takes your items by mistake.
- Do not dye, cut, or alter your hair in anyway without speaking to production staff first. This also includes your eyebrows or facial hair.
- If you are asked to straighten or curl your hair, please do so.
- Please arrive to makeup call with hair unstyled, unless you are given specific direction to do differently.
- GIRLS: For styles to hold better it is best if you wash your hair every other day, but not every day.
- BOYS: Please arrive to makeup call without product in your hair.
- Do not forget to set makeup before putting on costumes.
- DO NOT PUT ON COSTUME PRIOR TO PUTTING MAKE UP ON.

- Treat all costuming with respect.
- If something rips, tears, falls off, explodes, etc. please tell the (Mrs. Zimmer), our costumer right away. The sooner it's caught the easier it is to fix.
- Do not rough house, horse play, or goof off in costumes.
- ABSOLUTLEY NO EATING OR DRINKING IN COSTUME. Water and cough drops are the only
 exception to this rule.
- ALWAYS REMEMBER FOUNDATION GARMENTS IF YOU HAVE QUICK CHANGES. GIRLS: White Camis and Boy Shorts over undergarments. BOYS: White T-Shirt (Crew) and shorts over your underwear.
- Please make sure all costume pieces are accounted for before putting them on and before putting them away for the night.
- If something needs laundered please ask the costumer nicely.
- Please make sure all costumes return to designated areas. Check changing areas before you leave for items left behind.
- If an item is left behind and you aren't sure who it belongs to, give it to a member of the Production staff.

We also have special information on costuming for everyone. YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING ON SUNDAY:

Everyone will need to bring

- a skirt or pants (not leggings)
- a sweater, preferably with a print like snowflakes, but stay away from Christmas sweaters
- accessories such as a scarf, mittens, a hat, boots (Uggs or similar would be great), a shawl or wrap

If you are in the Summer Chorus, you are welcome to be a townsperson as well with the items above. You will need to bring the following for Summer:

- Bermuda-type shorts and a bright colored shirt (with a collar) or a bright summer dress
- Sandals or flip-flops

The Oakens and the Oaken family will need winter boots (like Uggs)

Girls will need character shoes or jazz shoes. Boys should have black dress shoes.
